



Determining Your MSU NetID

All Mississippi State University faculty, staff, and students have an electronic network identifier, the **NetID**. The **NetID** is a unique identifier for accessing a variety of information technology resources. NetIDs are displayed on MSU ID cards and on class rosters (for Faculty only). The step-by-step instructions below demonstrate how to determine your MSU **NetID**.

1. All MSU ID cards display the NetID underneath the MSU ID number.


